1. Qualification, Examination & Eligibility

a. Qualification & Eligibility

- i. To be eligible to apply for admission to the master of Engineering (ME) in Electronics & Telecommunication (E&T) course, a candidate should have passed,

BE in E &T or
BE in Electronics or
BE in Electrical or
BE Instrumentation or
BE in Computer

of the University of Mumbai.

OR

Bachelor of Engineering Degree in the aforesaid branches of any other University recognised as equivalent to BE of this University.

OR

Should have passed the examination conducted by the Institute of Engineers (India) and qualify to become Associate Member of Institution of Engineers (AMIE, India) in the aforesaid branches (Ref. University Circular No. 326 of 2004 dated 9/08/2004).

- ii. The sponsored candidate should have a minimum of 55% aggregate marks in the qualifying examination.

- iii. The sponsored candidate must have a minimum of two years full time work experience in a registered firm / company / educational and or research institution / a government department or government autonomous in the relevant field in which admission is being sought.

b. Examination (TERNET)

College will conduct its own qualifying examination & will conduct personal interviews for admission.

1. Reserved seats for B & C category candidates will be offered to the candidates in the respective category in the first round, strictly on the basis of merit decided and specified in the rules elsewhere.

5. Transfer certificate from the previous college
6. Caste Certificate, if required

6. Refund of Fees

If admission is cancelled before the cut off date, fees will be refunded after deducting cancellation charges Rs.1000/-. No fees will be refunded thereafter.

Caution money Deposit will be refunded after completion of the course.

No hostel accommodation is available at present.

Admission granted to students shall be provisional and will be subjected to the approval of the University of Mumbai.

7. Conduct And Discipline

While studying in the college if any student is found indulging in any anti-national activities contrary to the provision of acts and laws enforced by the government, any activity contrary to rules of discipline, will be liable to be expelled from the roll of the college without any notice, by the Principal.

8. Conduct of Minimum Attendance

No student will be allowed to appear in the examination if he does not attend minimum 75 % classes of theory, practical etc. Nor will he be allowed to appear for the examination if he fails to submit satisfactorily all the assignments, jobs, journals and reports, as specified by the university, within the stipulated time limits.

If any of the statement made in the application form or any information supplied by the candidate in connection with his / her admission is later on or at any time, found to be false or incorrect, his / her admission will be cancelled, fees forfeited and he / she may be expelled from the college by the Principal. An appeal against the order of expulsion, however may be made within 7 days, to the Director of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai, whose decision in such cases, will be final.

9. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. Please read the complete application form carefully before filling it up.
2. Fill in application form legibly and submit it to the college. The envelope should be marked as "Application for admission to ME".
3. In the event of admission being offered, the candidate will have to produce provisional eligibility certificate from the University of Mumbai, for the purpose of conforming the admission.
4. Candidates from the other Universities, who join the Institute on the basis of the provisional statement of eligibility from the University of Mumbai, must produce the necessary certificates required by the Mumbai University, for confirmation of eligibility within one month from the date of their admission. Failure to do so may lead to cancellation of admission.
5. The application must be accompanied by all the necessary certified true copies / Xerox copies of certificates, as mentioned in the application form. Do not attach originals.
6. All candidates of ME courses will have to appear for written test followed by an interview at TEC Navi Mumbai, at their own cost.
7. Candidates for being eligible for admission to the Master of Engineering in E&T must have obtained the degree of bachelor of Engineering in Electrical Engg. / Electronics Engg. / Computer Engg. / Instrumentation Engg. / Electronics & Telecommunications engineering (Ref. Mumbai University circular no. UG/326/of 2004 dated 09/08/2004, Ordinance no. – 05134).
